

City Of Crossville 2013 Christmas Parade

- GUIDELINES -

Thank you for your interest in the Annual Christmas Parade. We ask that all entries comply with the theme and be decorated accordingly. Please help us promote the holiday season by decorating your float, car, etc. in a festive manner.

Theme: "THE HEART OF CHRISTMAS"

Date: Saturday, December 14, 2013 at 4:30 PM

Entry Fee: NONE

1. All entries are expected to adhere to the theme (as stated above) and reflect Holiday and Community spirit. The City of Crossville Christmas Parade Committee reserves the right to deny participation in the parade to entrants not in compliance with this.
2. Parade Line-up will begin at 2:30 PM and will close at 4:00 PM. The parade will begin promptly at 4:30 PM. Late entries will be denied participation in the parade. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. **All motorized vehicles in the parade must:**
 - Operate under their own power (not towed by a pickup etc...)
 - Be **75% decorated** and in good condition. Please use your imagination, i.e. lights, wreaths, bows.
 - Units will be inspected before the parade begins.
 - Play only Christmas/Seasonal appropriate music.
 - There is a height limit of 13' 6".
4. **NO** float should have a live Santa Claus character. The City of Crossville float will have the only Santa and Mrs. Claus in the parade. Please allow the excitement and anticipation of the arrival of Santa Claus to be until the end of the parade.
5. All children participating in the parade must be supervised by an adult.
6. Entries with animals will be responsible for cleaning up after themselves. Be creative, example: Dress someone as an elf to help keep the parade festive and clean.
7. **NO** fire or pyrotechnics of any kind is allowed. No firing of firearms is allowed.
8. **ALL UNITS MUST GIVE WAY TO EMERGENCY VEHICLES.**
9. In case of inclement weather, announcements about the status of the event will be made on area radio stations.
10. Forward motion of the parade must be maintained at a constant even rate. No gaps or stopping is permitted between you and the entry in front of you. No spinning wheels, (burn outs) etc. on the parade route. **THIS WILL BE ENFORCED**
11. There will be one prize winner in each category and one over-all winner.
12. All entries will be previewed at line-up and judged on the parade route.
