Educators are at maximum capacity, cannot add anything else to their day

Lost true meaning of "community"

Lack of quality, affordable child care

Before/After School Care helpful

Rely too much on educators to teach soft skills

Hours of the Pre-K program limit those that can attend (i.e. pickup is at 2:15)
