The allotted time for construction for this contract is 90 calendar days. Liquidated damages are five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per calendar day.

Generator Manufacturers shall meet the following pre-qualification requirements to be eligible to be bid on this Contract:

1. **Pre-approval for all generator manufacturers other than those listed in the specifications herein shall be met by April 13, 2017. Any manufacturer not approved by this date is not eligible to be considered for this project. Requirements for pre-approval include but are not limited to the manufacturer having a highly qualified service facility within 150 miles of the project site. Likewise service provider shall have competent individuals capable of servicing generators of 400 KW and higher.**

All bidders must be licensed general contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1976 of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon. Each bidder shall write on the outside of the envelope containing his bid his contractor's license number, the expiration date, and that part of the classification applying to this bid. If this is not done, the bid will not be opened.

The provisions of TCA 62-6-119(b) require stating the names of the subcontractors for electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilating, and air conditioning on the outside of the bid envelope if the subcontract for same exceeds \$25,000. There is no masonry work on this project.

All bidders shall comply with all provisions of TCA 50-9-113 as it relates to Drug-Free Workplace requirements. The Contractor shall complete the Drug-Free Work Place Affidavit of the Prime Bidder form and submit it with his/her bid. The Contractor shall be responsible for any of its Subcontractor(s) compliance with said law.

All bidders shall comply with all provisions of Chapter 878 of TCA 12-4-1 as it relates to certification of compliance regarding illegal immigrants. The Contractor shall complete the Statement of Compliance Certificate Illegal Immigrants and submit it with her/her bid. The Contractor shall be responsible for any of its Subcontractor's compliance with said law.

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All bidders shall comply with all provisions of Chapter 817 of TCA 12-12-106 as it relates to certification of compliance regarding the Iran Divestment Act. The Contractor shall complete the Statement of Compliance Certificate Iran Divestment Act and submit it with her/his bid. The Contractor shall be responsible for any of its Subcontractor's compliance with said law.

In compliance with TCA 12-4-126(a) and (b) the ENGINEER will not issue addenda less than forty-eight (48) hours before the bid opening date and time; further, any questions concerning the bid documents shall be received by the ENGINEER before ninety-six (96) hours prior to the bid opening date and time.

The successful bidder is required to furnish both an acceptable performance bond and payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any all bids, to waive informalities, and to negotiate with the apparent qualified best bidder or bidders to such extent as may be necessary.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for 90 days, while the Owner considers the bids. Mutually agreed upon time extensions may be made if necessary.
