Fuel sales were the same in January as December and down from January last year. Weather and seasonality both contributed to a slow month. I don't attribute anything in the economy at this point to any downturn. The variation over last year is not enough to account for anything other than normal ups and downs.

We flew 131 hours in Crossville for flight training. Training activity continues to remain strong at Crossville. This was slightly down from previous months but expected since we had a significant amount of non-flying days in January.

Maintenance continues to be busy. We started two CCHS interns in January in our shop. Brenton finished his Airframe Certification today and he is now a cully certified A&P. Brandon started Bakers School in Nashville today and will come back with his A&P license in two weeks. We hired an additional mechanic in January who is an experienced A&P and IA, with significant turbine experience. This will allow us to expand the aircraft we work on to include single and twin turbine aircraft over the coming 12 months.
