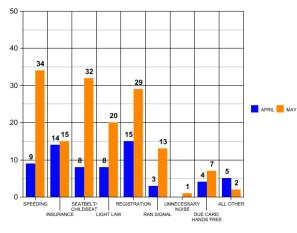


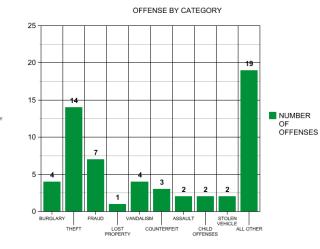


ARREST BY CATEGORY

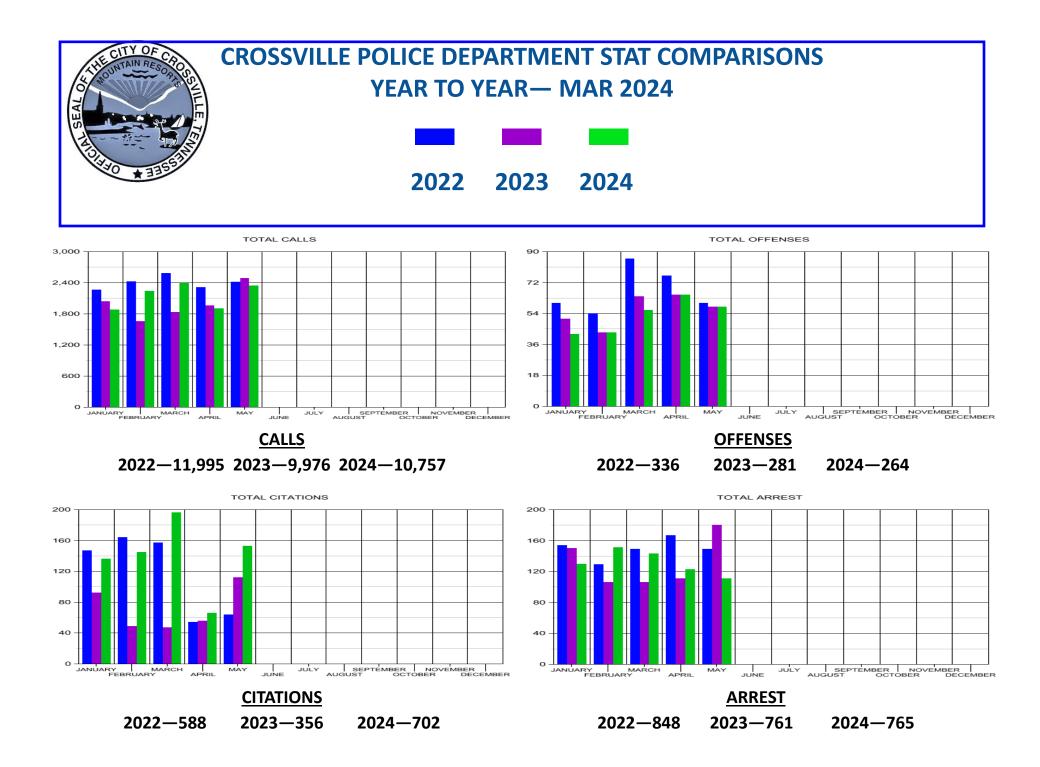

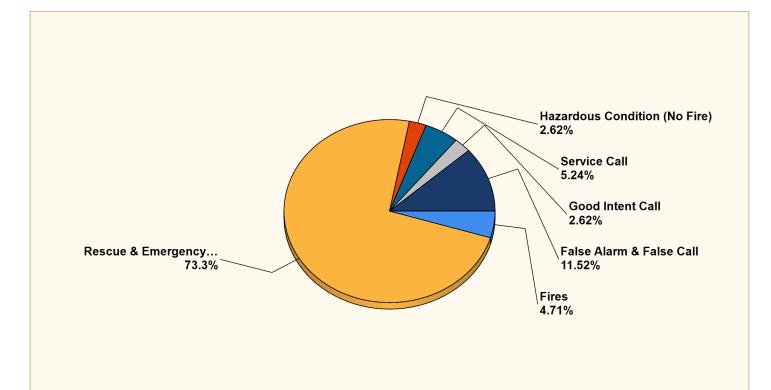

Fuel sales were up in May over April both in Avgas and Jet A. Year over year Fuel sales were down from last May 2023. General Aviation and Charter flights are down industry wide. Last year our based Jet customer had two aircraft in service versus one this year, which accounted for the larger Jet fuel sales volume.

The maintenance shop remains busy.

We now have two British Aerospace Jetstream J31 aircraft in charter service. They carry 10-12 passengers in a stand-up cabin at 275 mph cruise speed. Typical trips would be to Florida vacation destinations and business trips 300-600 miles one way.

We anticipate having our first jet aircraft in charter service in late July. We have been delayed getting it into service due to pilot staffing and availability of training slots for approved aircraft systems training.

We are still looking to hire additional Airframe and Powerplant Certified Mechanics full time to help us keep up with the workload of retail and charter maintenance. There is a national shortage of trained aircraft mechanics which is driving up the pay scales and making it difficult to recruit new talent.
